In addition to any other basis for the other person's belief that the offender will cause serious physical harm to the person or property of the other person, the other person's unborn, or a member of the other person's immediate family, the other person's belief may be based on words or conduct of the offender that are directed at or identify a corporation, association, or other organization that employs the other person or to which the other person belongs; TO WIT: Haley did state that she was going to return to Victim #1's residence and "blow [Victim #1's] brains out." This statement was made to a third party after she showed up at the aforementioned residence and was told to leave by law enforcement on scene. This is contrary to and in violation of Ohio Revised Code section titled 2903.21(A), Aggravated Menacing, a Misdemeanor of the First Degree.


