

COMPLAINT BY INDIVIDUAL  
(RULE 4)

DATE OF BIRTH: September 4, 2001

Complainant, being duly sworn, states that Clayton W. Drummond on or about Sunday, February 02, 2025 in Mercer County, Ohio, did No person, without privilege to do so and with purpose to prevent, obstruct, or delay the performance by a public official of any authorized act within the public official's official capacity, shall do any act that hampers or impedes a public official in the performance of the public official's lawful duties. TO WIT: Clayton W. Drummond did, without privelage to do so, impede the crash investigation that deputies were investigating by saying that he was not involved. Three other witnesses at the scene indicated that Clayton was driving the vehicle involved in the motor vehicle accident. This is contrary to and in violation of Ohio Revised Code section §2921.31(A)(1), titled Obstructing Official Business, a misdemeanor of the second degree.
