AFFIDAVIT ON COMPLAINT (O.R.C. 2935.09)

## STATE OF OHIO, MERCER COUNTY, SS:

I, Patrolman Connor J. Burr, do hereby state that I am employed at the Celina Police Department. The following did occur:

On June 9, 2025, at approximately 6:54 P.M, Ptl. Nelson and I observed a white truck travelling Westbound on West Wayne Street, in the City of Celina, Ohio. We saw the vehicle at the intersection at North Brandon Avenue. The windows were tinted to a darkness that I could not see inside to identify the driver.

As the vehicle travelled Northbound on North Brandon Avenue, I was pacing the vehicle in my patrol car, at a speed greater than the limit of 25 miles per hour. I also watched as the truck veered across the center line, into the other lane of travel. I initiated my overhead light bar and initiated a traffic stop.

I contacted the driver, whom I identified as Amanda K. Hatfield. Ptl. Nelson identified the passenger. Hatfield told me that she did not have a valid driver's license and that it was under suspension. I requested a K9 to my location to perform free air sniff. Deputy S. Heinl arrived at my location with his dog. His dog performed the sniff around the truck and told us that the dog alerted to the presence of an odor of narcotics.

I asked Hatfield to step out of the vehicle. I asked her if I could search her pockets and she said that I could. In her right front pocket, I located a small plastic baggy. I looked at it and found that it contained a crystal-like substance. I believed this to be methamphetamine. Ptl. Nelson looked at it as well, and from his training and experience, agreed that it was methamphetamine.

No other illegal items were located during the search of the occupants or the vehicle. Some of the contents of the baggy were field tested and tested positive for methamphetamine.

Hatfield was transported to the Mercer County Detention facility. At the jail, Hatfield admitted to Corrections Officers that she had been smoking methamphetamine.
